PREOPERATIVE INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Get a good night's sleep before your surgery.
- 2. Do not eat or drink anything, not even water, after midnight the night prior to your surgery unless otherwise directed by your doctor or nurse.
- 3. You must be accompanied by a responsible adult who needs to remain in the office for your entire treatment, be able to drive you home, and care for you following your surgery.
- 4. Wear loose, comfortable clothing with short sleeves. Eye makeup should be kept to a minimum, and false eyelashes or contact lenses should not be worn. Also, if you wear nail polish please remove the polish from one of the index fingers.
- 5. Good oral hygiene is essential for proper healing. Please follow your normal oral hygiene routine (brushing and flossing) the day of your surgery.
- 6. Please arrive 20 minutes prior to your scheduled surgery appointment time.
